It's easy for a parent to say, "clean your room", but to someone whose brain processes information differently, a simple chore can create more questions than answers.

Goblin Tools breaks down chores and projects into step-by-step instructions.

Like, "clean your room". Parents only have to type that into the Magic ToDo tool and tap a button for a checklist. Pick up clothes and throw them in the hamper, organize loose items into bins or drawers, make your bed, and so on.

More manageable for someone who's easily overwhelmed. The child or young adult can then mark step as 'done'.

And if you need to break down a task even more, just tap the button again.

There's an app for iPhone, and Android. And if a child has a computer or Kindle Fire Tablet, they can use the Goblin Tools website to see steps and mark them complete.

It isn't just for people on the spectrum. I've found it helpful for anything you're doing for the first time and for people who are easily distracted.

There are other Goblin tools. If you're sending someone a message or email, enter it in "The Judge" to detect tone. The Formalizer takes paragraphs and makes them more professional or more casual and checks for spelling errors.

I could spend a week breaking down a full description of everything Goblin Tools can do. It's just 99 cents in the app stores which goes to fund development. It's a game-changer for families of a neurodivergent child or adult. I'm Jamey Tucker and Goblin Tools is the app of the day.
